## Warren T. Eich Middle School 6th Grade Only Masquerade Ball Themed Dance Friday, March 29, 2019, 3:30 - 5:00 p.m.



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students:

We will have our second annual 6th Grade Only Dance on Friday, March 29, 2019, from 3:30-5:00 p.m. in the Warren T. Eich Middle School Multi-Purpose Room (MPR). The theme is "MASQUERADE BALL". Students are encouraged to wear nice clothing and an optional masquerade-style mask covering only half the face.

We would like to offer the students treats for the dance. Any donations of beverages, treats or finger foods would be sincerely appreciated. These may be dropped off before school in Room E-6 or by 3:00 pm in the main office on March 29, 2019.

The following rules will apply:

- 1. Only Eich 6th grade students will be allowed to attend the dance or be on campus.
- No one will be admitted to the dance after 3:45 p.m.
- 3. Once students arrive at the dance, they will not be allowed to leave until 5:00 p.m., or until they are checked out by their parent(s) or guardian(s).
- 4. Tickets will be sold for \$3.00 March 25th through March 28th during lunch in the MPR. Tickets will also be available for \$5.00 at the door.
- 5. Students on "Student Probation" will NOT be able to attend the dance. Students who have less than 85 merits will be given a reminder slip before the dance.
- 6. Arrangements should be made for students to be picked up **immediately** after the dance.
- 7. If a student is absent the day of the dance, they will **NOT** be allowed to attend the dance.
- 8. Students **must** follow the school/district dress code.
- 9. Students must obey all school rules.

## Conduct for dances:

- 1. No slam dancing safety is our #1 priority!
- Students shall dance in an appropriate manner. Unsafe, lewd, or yulgar dancing is not permitted. This includes "freak" dancing, crowd surfing, slam dancing, and any other type of dancing the adult supervisor feels is inappropriate.
- Students must obey and be respectful to all parent chaperones and teachers.

Students who violate any of the rules and conduct for dances will be removed from the dance and are subject to disciplinary action.
