PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS


- 1) Maintain a 70% cumulative average in all classes attended in the seventh and eighth grades.*
- 2) Attain a passing grade on the eighth grade Civics test (Constitution Test).*
- 3) Maintain **satisfactory attendance** of 90% or better from the time enrolled in school or attend a minimum of 162 days out of the required 180 days during the eighth grade year.*
- 4) Maintain **satisfactory citizenship** as delineated in the student handbook. Students who are on probation are not eligible for promotion activities. Any student who falls below 85 merits is placed on probation and must get their merits back up to 100 to be taken off probation.*
- 5.) Successful completion of the IB Community Service Project.
